Activities that impact ROI:

Prework: massivework which many facilitators not invest their time in. Like to invest in preworkinitial contract we plan - Dont know waht I want . What i think i want cant state. that lays the foundation...neat, clean (Simple) and Crisp(Achlevable) ROI With every intervention, what was the impact on the group / organization/ show impact at every stage of intervention : Expectation vs impact-whats working/not working - 2 way approach - thus helping a long term

Co ownership of the intervention & follow thru

Understand and address the pain points and link it to business impact, then accomplish the learning objective

Role play as an activity to simulate the situation Activities that impact ROI

Spectactor's intervention and play back theatre Achieve the desired outcome in the facilitation process

Continual Peer learning

FGD to have robust session plan Kirkpatrick model list out intangibles and Tangibles (Questionnaire, feedback survey, discussions with the stakeholders, measurements in terms of metrics).

Hardy Alexander and Bharti Maru facilitated a highly interactive and insightful session: 'Ignite the Leader in You' for Christ University students.



The IAF Endorsed™ Facilitator (EF) designation is a first stage of the IAF Professional Development Pathway.

It has been specially designed for members who may be considered a practitioner in the field of facilitation. For this reason, it is particularly suitable for members who are at the early stages of their career as facilitators or may work primarily as a consultant, project manager, trainer, coach, or meeting leader, independently or within an organisation.

The IAF Endorsed™ Facilitator assessment process is based on an online examination and a written submission. In order to become an IAF Endorsed™ Facilitator members must demonstrate an understanding of the IAF Core Competencies, have practical experience using facilitation tools, techniques and/or methods, and conduct in congruence with the IAF Statement of Values and Code of Ethics
